



WELCOME TO CINEHILL FESTIVAL'S POP-UP CAMPSITE

The campsite is free of charge and intended for festival visitors.
For a more pleasant stay, please follow the campsite rules.

ARRIVAL

Upon arrival, the campsite is not accessible by car. Please park your vehicles in Delnice (preferably in the festival parking lot located at the school playground), and take the festival bus to the Petehovac excursion area. Tickets for the bus, as well as the necessary information, are available at the Festival Info Point at café Moloko in Delnice. The bus departs from the same location.
The price of a daily wristband for multiple bus rides is €4.
The price of a multi-day bracelet for all festival days is €10.

CAMPERS' CODE

Paying the tourist tax in the amount of €1.06 per day is mandatory for all visitors (this obligation is legally prescribed for all tourists in the Republic of Croatia). The fee is charged on a per-person rate, not per tent. It is assumed that all campers will stay until the end of the festival, so the tourist tax is calculated on this basis – from the moment of registration until the last day of the program in Gorski Kotar. If you are arriving from the Motovun campsite, you still need to register again.

Registration for the campsite is possible at the festival ticket office located at the Petehovac excursion area.

Please note The tourist tax can only be paid in cash.

Along with the campsite registration, you have to purchase one of the ticket packages. If you did not buy the Big Hill or Little Hill package in advance, you have to buy the 3-ticket Camper package for €12 upon registration. Tickets from the package (vouchers) need to be exchanged for individual tickets for the screening of your choice at the festival box office.

Holders of festival accreditations may stay at the campsite without purchasing tickets.

As a sign of properly regulated camper status, you will receive a camper's wristband. Please wear it for the duration of your stay. You may exchange your ticket packages (vouchers) for individual tickets only upon presentation of the wristband.

The campsite is equipped with showers, available only to registered campers and with the use of environmentally friendly soaps and shampoos. Anyone who uses products that are not environmentally friendly may use the showers at the Sports Hall in Delnice every day from 10 a.m. to 1 p.m.

All unregistered campers run the risk of incurring hefty fines for unregistered stays, which are issued by the tourist inspection.

In case of really inclement weather, be sure to move away from woodland areas in order to avoid injury from broken branches falling.
